## Matters arising from previous minutes:

- No action regarding the bent fence via the AHPC at the Nationals, the Moore family believe that the damage was already there.
- Bill Kerr noted that the Cunningham Club are happy to host the 2017 Cooper Cup. Discussion re: holding the next Cooper Cup or similar in North Qld.

Noted that funding for the planned lvl1 coaching course in Emerald is in the next financial year's budget (approx. \$4-5,000).

- After much discussion it was agreed that selectors are to pick four development squads from all Queensland players, to improve the QPA talent identification pathway for juniors, intermediates, open and master's players (20 of each gender). These squads may be added or subtracted from at the selector's discretion throughout the season. The squads are to be presented for ratification at the next MC meeting (Wandoan, 1/9/2016) for release after the Junior & Intermediate Trials.
- Late nominations were discussed and it was agreed that no late nominations will be accepted.
  The point was made that if players cannot be bothered to nominate they are not keen to be
  considered. Gillian to provide the Selectors with the nomination lists just prior to nominations
  closing to ensure all nominations have been correctly captured utilising the new database
  nomination process.

## Bauhinia fields (2017 Zone Titles):

Write a letter to Bauhinia PC noting that the MC have concerns that the club's main field, in its
current heavy condition, is not up to the required standard for the 2017 Qld. Zone
Championships. Request that the issue be addressed and the QPA be updated on the measures
taken, note that the field will be inspected in the coming months.

- Leichardt zone, write to Dirranbandi asking them to revisit the requested 2017 carnival date as it will clash with the Tara Intermediate carnival.

  - junior & intermediate trials

## **Board Evaluation:**

- All agreed this was healthy process for the QPA, shows room for improvement particularly with regard to communication. The same process will be conducted each year.

- Discussion held regarding the lack of easy access to and understanding of QPA Policy & Procedures Manual that is more than just a list of the motions passed at MC meetings and AGMs. Louie to work with Gillian on the drafting of this to be tabled at the next MC meeting.

## Policy re: change of carnival dates due to wet weather

to share their date when another clubs carnival has been cancelled due to wet weather.
 Determined to continue with the current policy but noted that the MC can contact clubs and
encourage, but not demand, co-operation for the betterment of polocrosse. Carnivals can run
after the state titles.
