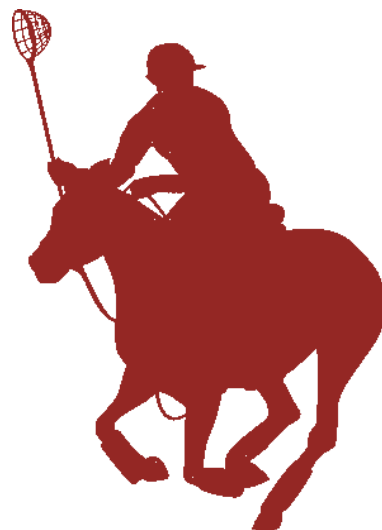


It's time to get back in the saddle and have some fun!

HOW TO FIND IT Look for the signs on the Kennedy Highway, south of Mt Garnet

- *Please note this event is being held at the Station House Complex, not the Yards.*

30kms south of Mt Garnet, 37 kms north of Forty Mile Scrub

RN 20719, turn south off Kennedy Hwy at 20 Mile Creek, Mt Garnet (8klm dirt driveway).

- Allow 3.5 hours drive from Cairns or 5 hours drive from Townsville (via Hervey's Range/back road).
